### 3. The purposes of and the legal basis for the processing of your personal data

We are processing your personal data for the following purposes:

The purpose of the processing of the application is that manufacturers or the company responsible
for the first marketing in Denmark must register the products (food supplements) that one wishes to
sell.

The legal basis of our processing of your personal data is:

- Order no. 1239/2017 on food supplements.
- Article 10 in regulation 2002/46.

### 4. Categorization of personel data

We are processing the following categories of personal data about you:

 Name, address, contact person, business registration number (CVR-number), e-mail and phone number.

# 5. Recipients or categories of recipients

We publish your personal data on the website of the Danish Veterinary and Food Administration. The purpose of publishing the food supplements is to create transparency for the retailers and the consumers in order to make publicity on food supplements registered in Denmark.

#### 6. Storage of your personal data

We are currently not able to inform you the period for which your personal data will be stored. We can however inform you that we will base our assessment on the period of the storage on whether the purpose of the storage of the data is still relevant, when assessing the period of the storage.

All data is retained in accordance with the principles in the Danish Public Information Act, as such being accessible in consideration of the public information in the government. Moreover Rigsrevisionen (the Danish national audit) and the Danish National Archives' recommendations for archives are followed.

#### 7. Your rights

In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation you have a number of rights regarding our treatment of your personal data. If you wish to use your rights, please contact us.

#### The right to request access

You have a right to request access to the personal data, we are processing about you, and some other information.

#### The right to rectification

You have a right to rectification of inaccurate information about you.

### The right to erasure

In special cases you have the right to have information erased, within the time of our usual general period of storage.

# The right to restriction of processing

In special cases you have the right to have your processing restricted. If you have the right to restriction of processing, we are only allowed to process data – apart from storage - with your consent, or for the purpose of determine enforcing or defending legal claims, or protection of a person or vital social interests.

# Right to object processing

In special cases you have the right to object our legal processing of your personal data.
